Digital Skills sessions takes a break

Our Digital Skills and Scams Awareness sessions are now 'taking a break' over the winter period, in part due to consistently low numbers of people accessing the service. These were led by Age UK Lindsey staff and volunteers, running twice a month from Trinity Methodist Church.

The team provided one-to-one help with using your tablet, laptop or phone, answering all manner of queries and worries! They supported with accessing emails, taking photographs, changing details online, viewing NHS records, and getting confident using different devices.
